The Shooting competition

The Shooting competition at the Baku 2015 European Games will be held from 16 June to 22 June 2015 at the Baku Shooting Centre in Baku. The competition will consist of 19 medal events, summarised below:

A total of 330 athletes, including 210 men and 120 women, may take part in the Shooting competition.

The rules

The Shooting competition will be held in accordance with the editions of the following documents that are in force at the time of the Games:

- **Guidelines of ESC** (available at www.esc-shooting.org)
- **ISSF Official Statutes: Rules and Regulations** (available at www.issf-sports.org)

Scoring

In qualification for the rifle events, the centre of the target will be worth a maximum 10. For air rifle and 50m prone the target will be 10.9. In the finals, the 10 rings will be subdivided into 10 'decimal' score zones from 10.0 up to a maximum

10.9. In each event, the score from the final will not be added to the qualification score to determine the rankings. In finals, all athletes start on zero. The pistol events will be scored in the same way as some rifle events, but on full rings.

For finals in the 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men event, a "hit-or-miss" logic is used to determine scores, starting from zero. For finals in 25m Pistol Women divided in two stages, where one is the elimination round, and the other consists of the medal matches, also building upon the "hit-or-miss" approach, starting from zero.

In the shotgun events, a hit will be declared when at least one visible piece is seen by the referee to fall from a target or if powder emerges from the target after a shot. In each event, no scores from the qualification round will be carried forward to the final to determine the rankings.

Tie-break procedures

Ties occurring during the qualification phase will be broken according to ISSF Rules (which vary from event to event). Ties occurring in semi-finals, finals or medal matches will be broken by shoot-offs.

Penalties/disqualification rules

Score protests: a shooter may make a score protest about the value of a shot. If this is denied a two-point penalty is automatically incurred. Such protests are resolved by the Classification Jury using accredited techniques. Other penalties/disqualifications will be in accordance with the ISSF Rules.

Appeals and protests

Appeals and protests must be submitted within the specific times for each event, as stated in the ISSF Rules. Official results will not be published until any problems have been resolved.

Sport-specific events

Competition draw

The draw for all events will be conducted at 12:00 on 14 June 2015 at the Baku Shooting Centre. All team managers are eligible to attend. The draw will be conducted in accordance with ISSF Rules, and will be held more than 24 hours before the start of Pre-Event Training (PET). The results of the draw will encompass start lists, lane allocations and assignment of targets for all events in the schedule.

The technical meeting will be conducted by both Technical Delegates and competition management, and will be held in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations. All NOC team managers must attend.

Warm-up procedures

Each range will have a dry training and warm-up area. All athletes must comply with the warm-up and call procedures detailed in the ISSF Rules and Regulations (Finals in Olympic Rifle and Pistol events/Finals, Shotgun Events).

The venue

The Baku Shooting Centre is a brand-new purpose built shooting facility for the Baku 2015 European Games, and will form part of the lasting legacy left by Baku 2015. This new facility is due for completion in December 2014.

Field of play

The competition venue will contain the following competition areas:

- One rifle/pistol qualification range for 10m events
- One pistol qualification range for 25m events
- One rifle/pistol qualification range for 50m events
- One rifle/pistol finals hall for 10m, 25m, and 50m events
- Five shotgun ranges, including a finals range

All competition areas and all equipment will be provided in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

Facilities

The following facilities will be available at the competition venue:

- **An athletes' lounge, which will include services such as an athlete refreshment station, the Sport Information Desk, television with an in-venue live sports feed and Wi-Fi**
- **A broadcast mixed zone and an I-Zone (the I-Zone replaces the press mixed zone and media conference room at a competition venue). The Baku Shooting Centre and Mountain Bike Velopark will feature a shared I-Zone**
- **A doping control station**
- **Medical facilities and services such as field-of-play response team, spectator response teams and ambulance staff. Each venue will have at least one medical person with Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support certification**
- **Physiotherapy services featuring internationally trained physiotherapists**
- **A Sport Information Desk, offering services including distribution of general sport information, results and other key competition information**

Transport

The approximate travel time from the Athletes Village to the Baku Shooting Centre is 19 minutes. All travel times are subject to being refined in tandem with the road infrastructure delivery.

Weather

Due to its location on the southwest Absheron Peninsula, Baku is characterised by its warm temperatures and strong winds all year long, and summers are usually hot and dry. Based on statistics from recent years, the mean temperature is approximately 23°C (73°F) in June with around 15 hours of daylight. In June, the prevailing wind direction is from the north, with a mean wind speed of 6.5 m/s.

Qualification and entry

All information on qualification and entries for Shooting can be found in the Shooting qualification system, distributed by BEGOC. NOCs should check online for regular updates to the qualification criteria, which will be made available to all NOCs on the e-Qəzet (the NOC Extranet).

Training

Training for the Shooting competition will take place at the Baku Shooting Centre. Unofficial training will begin on 12 June. Official training will take place in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

Additional information

All athletes will be allocated Pre-Event Training (PET) start list, on the same lane on which they will be competing, within 24 hours of the start of their event.
