<p>Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter (at all times) may participate in the European Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter in force during the qualification period for the European Games up until the end of the period of the European Games.</p> <p>Age Requirements</p> <p>There are no age requirements for athletes competing in Athletics at the Baku 2015 European Games.</p> <p>Medical and Anti-Doping Requirements</p> <p>To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, athletes are bound by the IAAF and the World Anti-Doping Code.</p> <p>Additional European Athletics Requirements</p> <p>To be eligible to participate in the 2015 European Games, all NOCs must have competed in the 2014 European Athletics Team Championships.</p>
