#### 4. Type of Allocation of Quota Places

Quota places will be allocated to the respective NOC and not to Competitor(s) that achieved the place in the qualification event.

### C. Eligibility

Athlete Eligibility
<p>Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter (at all times) may participate in the European Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter in force during the qualification period for the European Games up until the end of the period of the European Games.</p> <p><b>Age Requirements</b></p> <p>No age limit is applicable for all athletes participating in the Baku 2015 European Games.</p> <p><b>Medical and Anti-Doping Requirements</b></p> <p>To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, all athletes must satisfy the medical requirements according to FIBA Medical and Anti-Doping Committee</p> <p>To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, all athletes must comply with anti-doping controls in accordance with the FIBA and WADA Doping Rules</p> <p><b>Additional FIBA Europe Requirements</b></p> <p>A player is eligible to participate in the European Games if he/she is registered at 3x3planet.com and has competed in a minimum of 2 FIBA-endorsed 3x3 events in the 12 months prior to the deadline for players' registration for the European Games.</p>

### D. Qualification Process

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

## E. Confirmation process for Quota Places

Top 15 men's teams and top 15 women's teams from the European Championship ranking will automatically qualify. Should the Host Country reach the top 15, the 16<sup>th</sup> best ranked team will qualify as well.

BEGOC on behalf of FIBA Europe will inform NOC in writing on 15 January 2015 of the quota places achieved through the European Championship.

Eligible NOCs must inform BEGOC and FIBA Europe in writing by 30 January 2015 whether or not they intend to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games.

By 1 February 2015 FIBA Europe will reallocate all available quota places.

## F. Reallocation of unused quota places

Should an NOC return a quota place that has been obtained, the 16<sup>th</sup> best ranked team of the European Championships would have priority for the unused quota place. However, if the Host Country reaches the European Championships all 16 teams will automatically qualify. If any NOC then rejects the assigned quota place, the best ranked European Federation in the official 3x3 Federation Ranking as off 1 February 2015, which has not yet qualified through European Championships will then qualify.
